GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE



- Water/Soap or Sanitizer at Entrance/Exits
- Temperature recording twice a day
- Temperature recording at entrance (Maximum 37.4 degrees celcius)
- Observe social distancing (2 meters) and hygiene
- Mandatory face masks for all patrons
- Send all testing data to Command Centre in Real time
- Registers to be sent to Command Centre
- Business resumes 8th to the 15th of May (25% capacity)
- 15th 22nd of May (50% capacity)
- From 22nd May (100% capacity) unless directed by the Director of Health Services



MALLS, COMMERCIAL OUTLETS (ALL)



- Water/Soap or Sanitizer at Entrance/Exits
- Temperature recording at entrance (Maximum 37.4 degrees celcius)
- Referral of "suspected cases" to health sector
- Employees to wear face mask
- Mandatory face masks for all patrons
- Register sent to command Centre
- 2-3 times a day Cleaning /Disinfection
- Business resumes 8th to the 15th of May (25% capacity)
- 15th 22nd of May (50% capacity)
- From 22nd May (100% capacity) unless directed by the Director of Health Services

SHOPS

Additional Shops:
(Clothes, Dry Cleaners, Tailors)



- Water/Soap or Sanitizer at Entrance/Exits
- 2-3 times a day Cleaning /Disinfection
- Temperature recording at entrance (Maximum 37.4 degrees celcius)
- Mandatory face masks for all patrons
- Employees to wear face mask
- Employee Check in/out register sent to command Centre
- Business resumes 8th to the 15th of May (25% capacity)
- 15th 22nd of May (50% capacity)
- From 22nd May (100% capacity) unless directed by the Director of Health Services

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Taxis, Buses, Combis, Train



- Water/Soap or Sanitizer at Boarding/Exits
- Cleaning /Disinfection after every trip
- Temperature recording at entrance (Maximum 37.4 degrees celcius)
- Registration of all passengers
- Register sent to command Centre
- Mandatory face masks for all patrons
- Business resumes 8th to the 15th of May (25% capacity)
- 15th 22nd of May (50% capacity)
- From 22nd May (100% capacity) unless directed by the Director of Health Services

SOCIAL AND CULTURAL GATHERINGS

Funerals, Churches etc



- Up to 5 members of the immediate family allowed cross boundaries
- Up to 10 people at places of worship
- Temperature recording at entrance (Maximum 37.4 degrees celcius)
- Max 50 people allowed to attend
- Face Mask for all attendees
- Provide Water/Soap or Sanitizer
- Attendance Register- Home and Mortuary
- No Food
- Whole service should be less than 2 hours
- Register sent to command Centre
