COVID-19 LOCKDOWN FOR GREATER GABORONE ZONE **(30TH JULY TO 13TH AUGUST 2020)**

Following the declaration of a lockdown for the Greater Gaborone Zone (Zonal Map attached for ease of reference) by His Excellency the President of the Republic of Botswana with effect from 30th July 2020 at midnight to the 13th August 2020 through Government Notice No. 311 of 2020, the conditions set out in Circular Savingrams DP 19/72 VIII dated 2nd and 9th April 2020 regarding the COVID-19 lockdown are hereby reinstated for the Greater Gaborone Zone **only**.

The Directorate would like to emphasize that the extreme social distancing conditions set out in the abovementioned correspondence are effected over the Greater Gaborone Zone **only** for all Public Service employees except those performing essential service and approved critical services. Employees are expected once again to remain at home and not move around, but must remain accessible as they are considered to be on duty; and may be recalled.

Addresses are advised to ensure that they operate with the least possible number of critical service employees during this time.

Public officers outside the Greater Gaborone Zone are therefore not affected by this development and are, as a consequence expected to continue with work as usual within the COVID-19 protocols in their respective areas.

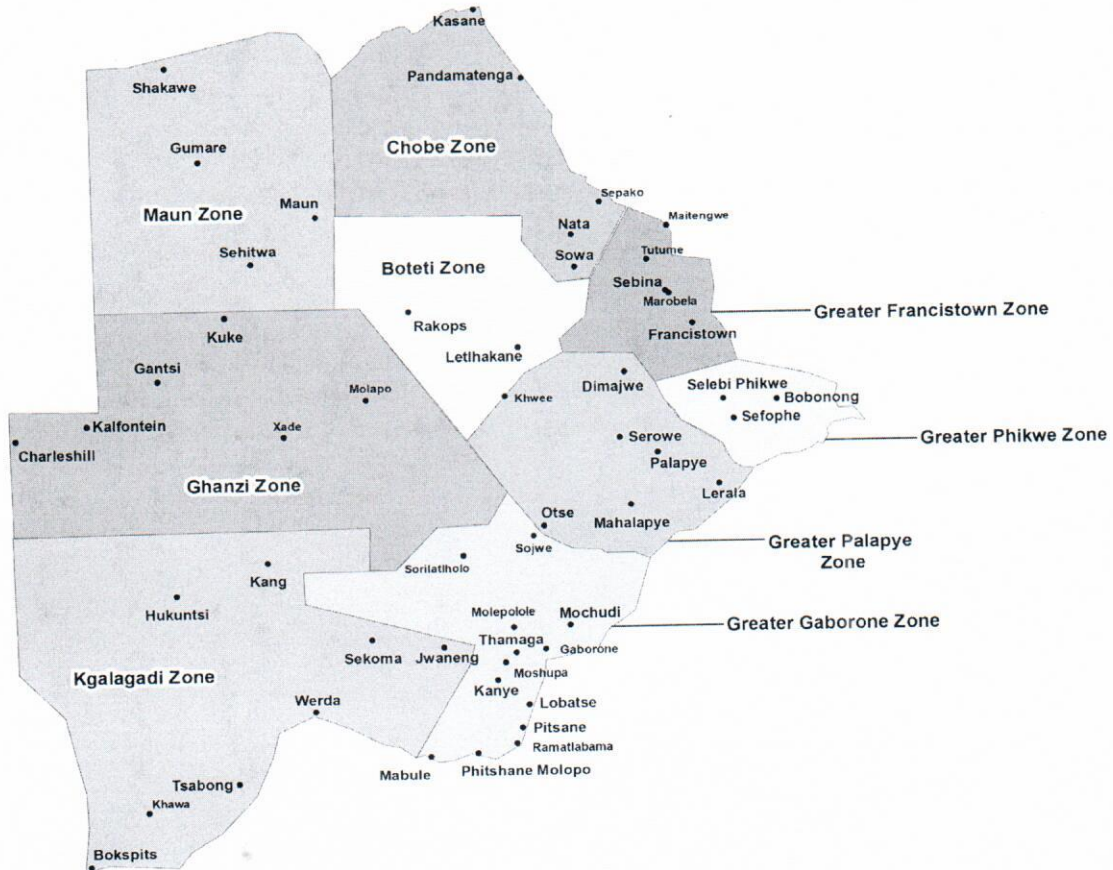
