

INVITATION TO STAKEHOLDERS FOR INPUT ON CODE OF CONDUCT FOR BROADCASTERS DURING ELECTIONS

The Botswana Communications Regulatory Authority (BOCRA or the Authority) is a statutory body established under the Communications Regulatory Authority Act [CRA Act No. 19 of 2012] with the responsibility for the regulation of the communications sector in Botswana, comprising telecommunications, Internet and Information and Communications Technologies (ICTs), radio communications, commercial broadcasting, postal services and related matters.

BOCRA has produced a Draft Code of Conduct for broadcasters during Elections. The Code will be enforced during the 2014 elections and will be binding to the licensed broadcasters. Therefore, BOCRA invites stakeholders to make input to the Draft Code of Conduct for consideration.

The deadline for submissions is on the 25th July 2014 at 17:00hrs.

BOCRA will consolidate all input and may hold a workshop on the same before the document is finalised.
