INVITATION TO STAKEHOLDERS TO MAKE INPUT TO THE DISCUSSION ON LICENSING FRAMEWORK OF CAMPUS RADIO BROADCASTING

Botswana Communications Regulatory Authority (BOCRA or the Authority) is a statutory body established under the Communications Regulatory Authority Act [CRA Act, 2012] with a responsibility to regulate the communications sector in Botswana, comprising telecommunications, Internet and Information and Communications Technologies (ICTs), radio communications, broadcasting, postal services and related matters.

The Authority is planning to develop a Licensing Framework for Campus Radios in line with its mandate to make provision for licensing of academic training institutions radios. The objective of the framework is to enable the tertiary institutions to provide a broadcasting training platform for students and information sharing.

BOCRA invites tertiary institutions, broadcasters, students and all other interested stakeholders to make comments to the proposed **LICENSING FRAMEWORK OF CAMPUS RADIO BROADCASTING** as described in the **DISCUSSION DOCUMENT.** The deadline for submission of input is the **18**th **December 2019 at 17:00hrs**. Upon receipt, BOCRA will consider all inputs, and determine the way forward.
