

POSTAL SERVICE OPERATORS OFFERING INTERCONNECTION

The Botswana Communications Regulatory Authority (BOCRA or the Authority) is mandated through the Communications Regulatory Authority Act (No. 19 of 2012) (CRA Act) to regulate the communications sector in Botswana, comprising Telecommunications, Internet and Information and Communication Technologies, Radio Communications, Broadcasting, Postal Services and related matters.

BOCRA is therefore, responsible for, among others, the supervision of the Postal Services in Botswana as well as to ensure that, as far as practicable, there is provision of safe, reliable, efficient and affordable Postal Services throughout the country.

In pursuit of this mandate, BOCRA has developed Interconnection and Network Access Guidelines for the Postal Sector in Botswana to facilitate mutually beneficial interconnection of postal or courier service networks under transparent, proportional and non-discriminatory conditions.

Additionally, postal service operators were requested to develop and make public their Reference Interconnection Offers (RIOs) which outline conditions under which they would offer interconnection to other licensed service providers.

To this effect the following postal operators have submitted their RIOs with Authority which are also available at their offices and websites as the case may be:
