**Foreign-owned companies shall sub-contract up to 30% of the contract to 100% citizen owned companies.**

Preferences will be applied as per the Economic Diversification Drive (EDD), Citizen Empowerment Scheme and Presidential Directive CAB 34 (B) 2014 for locally manufactured goods and services.

If a bidder is a manufacturer, he/she shall be required to submit a copy of the Economic Diversification Drive Certificate, certified by the issuing authority.
